Qualifications, experience and skills (relevant to the role) that you will bring to this position



I would like to express my interest in continuing as the Umpire Convenor, a role I have dedicated myself to over the past 11 years. Throughout this time, I have overseen significant growth in our umpiring squad, expanding from just 5–6 umpires to a robust team of over 50, with accreditation levels ranging from All Australia (AA) to National C.

Under my leadership, the QLD Suns umpiring program has evolved into a well-structured, three-tier system, complemented by the continued development of our Strength & Conditioning program. This initiative plays a crucial role in maintaining peak fitness levels and enhancing physical strength, ensuring our umpires are well-prepared for the demands of the game. Through tailored training plans and expert guidance, we emphasize injury prevention, endurance, and overall athletic performance.

A key focus of my tenure has been education and professional development. To support this, I have organised virtual sessions via Microsoft Teams, covering essential topics such as rule changes, rule clarifications, game management, fostering respect within the game, managing disappointment, and building strong rapport with players and coaches. These sessions have been enriched by insights from some of the world's most highly regarded Umpires, providing our team with invaluable knowledge and best practices.

In addition to virtual learning, we have facilitated in-person workshops with leading industry professionals. Sessions with a Sports Exercise Physiologist have helped our umpires understand effective load management and injury prevention techniques, while consultations with a Nutritionist have provided strategies for optimizing nutrition to support both training and performance at Nationals.
